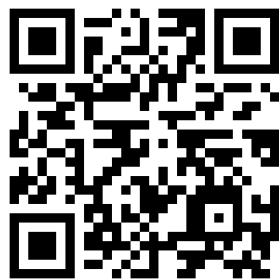

A message from

CHAPEL OF ST. JAMES–THE–LESS

A National Historic Site



"In its vigorous, harmonious composition, this small funeral chapel is a splendid example of High Victorian Gothic design. Its sense of strength and spirituality is derived from the subtle contrast of its stone walls, enveloping roofs, and soaring spire. The chapel was erected in 1860 to the plans by Cumberland and Storm, one of Toronto's leading 19th-century architectural firms. Situated on a slight rise, St. James is enhanced by the picturesque setting of its cemetery, which was opened in 1844 and is the oldest established cemetery in the city."

CASKET GRAVES – NEW SECTION AVAILABLE

Each single grave will accommodate two casket interments and also allow for the interment of cremated remains. Many of the locations available permit an upright monument.

CREMATION BURIAL PLOTS

For those who prefer in-ground interment of cremated remains. Included is a blank 18" X 12" unpolished pink granite flat memorial marker. Each plot will accommodate one to four interments.

COLUMBARIUM NICHES

Our outdoor columbarium is a granite-faced structure overlooking scenic Rosedale Valley. Each niche will accommodate a maximum of two standard size cremation urns.

SCATTERING GARDENS

Cremated remains can be scattered in one of our designated rose gardens. Our scattering areas feature a memorial plaque that can include the name of your loved one.



PRE-NEED / AT-NEED CREMATION & RELATED SERVICES

Pre-planning and immediate need cemetery services are available through our Office. Pre-planning gives you the time to make decisions and provides you and your family peace of mind. By purchasing at today's prices, you protect yourself from inflationary increases in the future.

MEMORIAL TREES AND PLAQUES

A selection of native trees is available to beautify the cemetery. Each tree comes with a 16" x 8" granite plaque that will sit flush with the ground.

MEMORIAL MARKERS AND MONUMENTS

A wide range of designs and granites are available for sale through the Cemetery Office. We will work with you to design and personalize a memorial that reflects your loved one.

INSCRIPTIONS

Additional lettering may need to be added at a later date. This service is available through our Office.

CREMATION URNS

A variety of urns is on display in the Cemetery Office.

MONUMENT CLEANING

This service involves power washing your monument to make it look new.

ANNUAL SPECIAL CARE

Arrangements can be made through our Office for planting flowerbeds, re-seeding and watering. Special Care season is from early June through to September.

CHRISTMAS WREATHS

Beginning in early November the Cemetery Office has a variety of wreaths for purchase.

All wreaths are removed by April 1st.
