INTERMENT AND SCATTERING RIGHTS

The prices for internment rights listed below include a non-refundable contribution to the cemetery's Care and Maintenance Fund. These prices do not cover the opening and closing of the grave, niche, or crypt (referred to as "internment fees"), memorialization costs (such as flat markers, upright monuments, inscriptions, etc.), or any associated installation fees.

Adult Full Casket Locations

A maximum of two caskets (2) and four (4) cremated remains may be buried in each grave unless otherwise specified on the Interment Rights Certificate. Where two caskets are interred in the same grave, the first casket must be buried at extra depth.

Please consult the office for details on sizing, we take no responsibility for supplied urns that might not fit within the allowed niche space.

Care and Maintenance Fund Contribution

As required under the Funeral, Burial, and Cremation Services Act, 2002, and Ontario Regulation 30/11, the amounts below will be contributed to an irrevocable trust fund known as the Care and Maintenance Fund/Account. Income (interest) from this fund is used to cover care and maintenance expenses of the cemetery in perpetuity.

CREMATORIUM SERVICES

The below price of a cremation will have the cremated remains presented in a plastic/cardboard container that is suitable for interment or scattering.

Our typical turnaround time is 3 to 5 business days. Expedited cremation is available for an additional fee, described below. Removal of pacemakers and other implants is mandatory, and a licensed funeral director must complete this procedure before cremation. If a person was undergoing brachytherapy (radioactive theraseeds) or radioisotope treatments before death, it is possible that the deceased may not be able to be cremated, please consult with us for further details.

Regulatory Fees

Fee charged by the Bereavement Authority of Ontario (BAO), a government delegated authority and not-for-profit corporation administering provisions of the Funeral, Burial and Cremation Services Act, 2002 (FBCSA) on behalf of the Ministry of Public and Business Service Delivery. This fee applies to each service activity performed and rendered. A "service activity" includes the interment of a casket, the interment of cremated remains, the entombment of a casket in a mausoleum crypt, the entombment of cremated remains within a niche, the scattering of cremated remains, reopening of a grave to place second remains on top (if not already at extra depth), and the cremation of human remains.

FUNDING AND PAYMENT OPTIONS

We accept Visa, MasterCard, debit card, cash, or cheque with two pieces of identification. Interac e-transfers may be sent to <u>cemetery@stjamescathedral.ca</u> noting the corresponding invoice. We are unable to offer pre-authorized payment from your bank.

Immediate Need (a death has occurred)

The Purchaser agrees to pay the total contract amount in full before the provision of services and supplies specified in the contract.

Financial assistance for burial and cremation services may be available through various governmental agencies, for those who qualify.

Pre-planning arrangements

Payment in full or monthly payment plans are available. A fee of \$20.00 will be charged on all payments not honored by the financial institution. If a death occurs, the plan must be paid in full before the burial, interment, or entombment date. For services and supplies that are being arranged pre-need, you may pay for them at today's price. We will place your money in a trust account, where it will accrue interest until the prepaid contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered).

Prepayment can be made by cash, cheque, or credit. Funds are held in the purchaser's name.

Guarantee

When paid in full following the payment terms set out in the prepaid contract, the prepaid contract is guaranteed. The total payment(s) made plus interest/growth earned will be applied to the future price of the services and supplies. If the total payment(s) plus interest/growth earned are insufficient to cover the total future price of the prepaid services and supplies, we will absorb the difference as a loss. Any funds more than the total future price of the prepaid services and supplies will be returned or applied toward additional services, supplies, and disbursements purchased at the time of need, as applicable. Conditions apply. Any changes to the prepaid contract may result in the prepaid contract being null and void and a new contract being executed with current pricing at the time changes are made.
